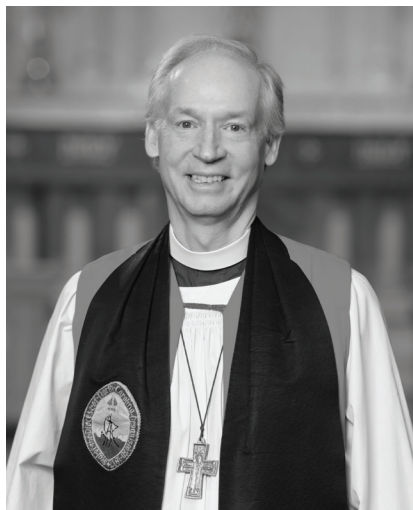

# A MESSAGE FROM *Bishop Samuel Rodman*

This year of discipleship is marked by a couple of significant changes in leadership, in our country and in our church. In November we welcomed a new presiding bishop, Sean Rowe, and days later we elected a new president. Leadership is not only about who and how we lead but also about who and how we



follow. It is about shaping and building character, as well as building beloved community. It is also always, as our outgoing presiding bishop has reminded us, about loving God, loving our neighbor and loving the most vulnerable among us.

Being a disciple of Jesus means sharing our faith in an inviting way that leads with love. Discipleship is about respecting the dignity of every person as a beloved child of God. Holy Scripture is full of stories of people who responded to God's call, who were faithful in their intention to spread the Good News, and who, above all, struggled to embody the love of Jesus in a way that others would find inspiring and compelling. We look to our leaders to do the same. We look to the stories of Scripture for inspiration, hope, examples and models of what faithful discipleship can look like, as well as

cautionary tales about how NOT to go about our work as proclaimers of the gospel of Jesus.

The biblical history, letters and prophetic accounts, along with the teachings and wisdom literature, are some of the resources that help us to renew and refresh ourselves on this journey and to strengthen our commitment to a mission that is, again quoting our 27<sup>th</sup> presiding bishop, loving, liberating and life-giving. We become disciples to serve others in Jesus' name.

This booklet is designed to be used as part of your daily prayer, and it can also be used to inspire, energize, focus, and strengthen individuals and congregations. It can be a blessing to you and an invitation to others with whom you may choose to share it.

Find a time that works for you to incorporate the reading from Scripture found here into your life of prayer. Find a way to incorporate the prayers for individuals and communities into your liturgy on a regular basis. Use this resource to propel you, in your own sense of mission, to share the joy of the Gospels and to share your own stories of faith with a neighbor or friend. Let this be a gift of grace as we enter more and more into the invitation to share the promises of Jesus. And let it be not only a witness to the gospel promises but also an illustration of the kind of leadership development that reflects these values of our Christian faith.

May this resource be a blessing to you and to your congregation as we live into our call as faithful disciples, as we seek to embody faithful leadership, and as we live into God's promise of building and Becoming Beloved Community.

# AN INTRODUCTION TO *Gospel-Based Discipleship*

## What is *Gospel-Based Discipleship* (GBD)?

*Gospel-Based Discipleship* is an encounter with the Gospel that is designed to engage people with the Gospel.

## Some Ways to Begin

There are many ways to read, study and meditate on passages of Scripture. You should use any approach that helps you engage the Gospel. I encourage you to incorporate this into other ways of daily devotions you may already use. Here is just one method of reflecting on the Gospel.

## Gospel Reflection

Begin with prayer.

1. Read the Gospel lesson for the day.

*What word(s), idea(s) or sentence(s) stand out to you?*

2. Re-read the Gospel (maybe in another translation if available).

*What is Jesus (the Gospel) saying to you?*

3. Re-read the Gospel.

*What is Jesus (the Gospel) calling you to do?*

Close with prayer.

## In *GBD*, there are no right or wrong answers.

The engagement is with the Gospel, not with a leader or the search for correct answers. Experienced leaders are not required, and leadership should rotate.

Groups and individuals using *GBD* regularly should expect to begin to see their call to mission differently. Some congregations use *GBD* as a way to focus on what God is calling them to do in their communities.
