Non-parochial and retired clergy who are canonically resident in this Diocese may apply for voting status, if they have not already done so, by completing the online annual Report of Acts of Ministry. The Bishop Diocesan, not the Secretary, grants voting status to non-parochial and retired clergy pursuant to the ministerial activity that you report each year. If you wish to change your canonical residence to this Diocese, please do not wait too late to pursue this with the Bishop Diocesan.

Non-parochial and retired clergy may register themselves for Convention by using the form on the website specifically marked for non-parochial and retired clergy, spouses, guests, observers, etc. The deadline to register non-parochial and retired clergy and others is October 31, 2024. However, if you wait that late, hotel rooms at the negotiated price may be sold out.

A separate registration process is used for parochial clergy and lay delegates, with a different deadline.

After you register, an email with payment instructions will be sent to you. If payment is made by check, please mail it to the address specified in the email.

The Diocese has discontinued paper mailings to clergy about Convention. In mid-August, the Secretary will email important material to every member of Convention. Therefore, ensure that your current email address is always on file with Ms. Elizabeth Dawkins, Executive Assistant to the Bishop Diocesan.
