The Constitution of the Diocese provides as follows for priests and deacons:

Note that parochial clergy may vote in the Convention of this Diocese **only** if they are canonically resident in this Diocese. If you wish to change your canonical residence to this Diocese, please initiate the change soon enough for the change to become effective prior to Convention.

The vestry clerk or other person who submits the lay delegation for a church and registers them for Convention also registers the parochial clergy of that church for Convention at the same time. The link to the registration system is found on the diocesan website. The deadline for registration is July 31, 2024. A separate process is used for non-parochial and retired clergy, with a different deadline.
