CHURCH OF THE ADVENT, ENFIELD

Organized 1874 – Built 1880

Designated 2015

ST. JAMES'S CHURCH, KITTRELL

Organized 1860 – Built 1861

Designated 1990; became active mission for a time,
then returned to Preserved Historic Church status

GRACE CHURCH, LAWRENCE

Organized 1891 – Built 1894

Designated 1991

ST. ANNA'S CHURCH, LITTLETON

Organized 1893 – Built c. 1896

Designated 2011

ST. LUKE'S CHURCH, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY

Organized & Built c. 1859

Designated 2007

ST. MARY'S CHAPEL, ORANGE COUNTY

Organized 1759 – Built 1859

Active committee prior to Historic Properties Commission

ST. JOHN'S CHURCH, WILLIAMSBORO

Organized 1771 – Built 1773

Active committee prior to Historic Properties Commission

ST. ANDREW'S CHURCH, WOODLEAF

Organized & Built 1840

Active committee prior to Historic Properties Commission

ST. GEORGE'S CHURCH, WOODLEAF

Organized & Built 1893

Designated 2007
