St. Timothy's Episcopal Church is seeking a rector for a full-time position for a congregation of 250 members. Our average Sunday attendance in 2023 was 90. This year we are averaging 94. We have two Sunday Morning Services (8 AM Rite I and 10:30 AM Rite II with music), a Wednesday Healing Service, and other services on Feast Days. Our full-time staff is our Rector and Parish Administrator. Our part-time staff includes our Youth and Children Coordinator, Music Minister, Financial Secretary, and Hospitality Coordinator.

Our Congregation participates in worship on Altar Guild Teams and as Ushers, Chalice Bearers, Acolytes, and Lay Readers. We have a vibrant group of Lay Eucharistic Ministers that visit members of our congregation weekly. Children's Church is led by our Director of Family Ministry and Evangelism each Sunday Our Social Ministry has grown and is one of our strengths. A few of our recent endeavors are working with RIP Medical Debt to eliminate \$5,693,434.59 of debt in 2023 and \$4,496,708 in 2024, hosting Red Cross Blood Drives twice a year, supporting the monthly food distribution at St. Marks, and hosting an annual lobster sale to raise money for outreach. Our Fellowship Ministry includes Wednesday Bible Study with a meal, our Parish breakfast on the second Sunday of the month, St Tim's Lunch Bunch after the 10:30 service on the first Sunday, a booth at Wilson Pride, and social events like our Super Bowl Party and Kentucky Derby Party.
